ADA Overview and Basic Legal Obligations

The ADA opens the doors to participation in employment, state, and local government programs, and more by prohibiting discrimination against people with disabilities, their families, and friends. This training will define disability, examine the rights of people with disabilities, and explain legal requirements for organizations under the ADA.

Accessible Communication

This training will focus on auxiliary aids and services for effective communication as well as resources for finding those services. Participants will learn best practices for making documents, social media content, online meetings, and other outreach measures accessible.

APRIL 12, 11:00 AM MT

Disability Etiquette

In this training, participants will learn the prevalence of disability, why access matters, and the importance of incorporating people with disabilities in decision-making. We will revisit the ADA's definition of disability, and learners will understand best practices for interacting with people with disabilities.

MAY 17, 11:00 AM MT

Emergency Preparedness and the ADA

Preparing for and responding to emergencies ensures that people with disabilities have access to critical services. Planning emergency preparedness by including people with disabilities will be discussed in this training, along with information on sheltering, specific needs, and communication
